L.E.R.T. Blessing Buckets

The Palatine Lutheran Early Response Team (L.E.R.T.), a joint ministry of Immanuel Lutheran Church and Prince of Peace, will be participating again in the LCC Blessing Bucket Project. We will be collecting items throughout August to assemble blessing buckets at a future meeting (date to be determined) that will be on-the-ready at Lutheran Church Charities (LCC) to be distributed to those affected by the aftermath of storms, floods or other disasters. Last year's buckets were all given out in Nebraska and were all well received. If able, you could donate one or several items or, if you prefer, prepare a complete blessing bucket. Buckets will be provided by a generous donation from the Palatine Home Depot. All donations are greatly appreciated. Starting in August, donations can be dropped off at Immanuel Lutheran Church in the bin in the Coats and Collections room off the church lobby. Thank you for partnering with us.

Below is a list of items to be assembled for a Blessing Bucket to be distributed by deployed LERT team members to any disaster affected families.

- 1 roll of paper towels
- 3-pack of pocket tissue packs
- 1 25-ct. roll of 30-gal. ultra strong garbage bags
- 4 5-ct. package of dust masks
- 2 pr. of reusable latex gloves (*i.e., Mr. Clean*)
- 2 pr. of jersey or canvas work gloves
- 1 large sponge
- 2-ct. bars of soap
- 1 package of reusable wipes (*i.e., Handi-Wipes, Brillo Basics*)
- 1 container of disinfectant wipes (*i.e., Lysol, store brand, etc.*)
- 1 package of personal cleansing wipes (*i.e., Wet Wipes, baby wipes, Simple*)
- 3 5-ct. 9x12" manilla envelopes (*for receipts, estimates, etc.*)
- Small first aid kit (*i.e., Welly Human Repair Kit, store brand 4x5 travel kit*)
- Family Care Pump Bug Spray – no aerosol cans

Most of these items can be purchased at Dollar Tree, Menards, WalMart or Target. The total cost of preparing a Blessing Bucket is \$35-\$40.
